The mother developed health issues a couple of years ago and passed away in November, leaving a husband and seven children, ages 2-18. The older son was supposed to graduate from high school in June, but had to drop out in April to help the father support the family. Fortunately the son is getting support from International Neighbors to prepare him to take the GED. We are thankful to be able to say 'yes' when we become aware of some of the needs in our community.
